Anna Thornton (Fernwood School, Wollaton) and Olivia Kay (Rushcliffe School) won WJ14 double sculls. This was their third win together as an unbeaten partnership. Olivia, current J 14 National Champion, won the WJ15 title, she is undefeated this year. Peter Savage (Djanogly City Academy) and Faisan Shah (Farnborough School, Clifton) won J 13 Double Sculls. National Champion Rowan Law from West Bridgford School won J 14 Sculls. Connor Gamble ( Dayncourt School, Radcliffe-on Trent ) took time out from double sculling to take the J 15 sculls. Dominic Parnell, Connor's doubles partner ( Grove School, Balderton ) won Novice Sculls. Connor and Dominic are J 15 Double scull National Champions.

Highlight of the afternoon was Olivia Duckworth ( Fernwood School, Wollaton ) who, despite being only 15, followed up her recent successes at Burton and the National Championships by winning Women's Intermediate 3 sculls.

Seven wins brings the current Nottingham Rowing Club's summer total to 87 wins as they move towards the minimum season's target of 100.
